ICE BREAKER

• Go around the circle and have each child say their name, grade, school and if they would rather be able to fly or have super strength!

LESSON REVIEW

- Because of Daniel's great ability, the king made plans to place him over the entire empire.
- Other administrators and high officers began searching for some fault in the way Daniel was handling government affairs, but they could not find anything to criticize or condemn.
- Daniel was faithful, always responsible, and completely trustworthy. So, they decided the only way to condemn Daniel would have to be because of his religion.
- A law was made where everyone would not be able to pray to anyone else except to the king. Anyone who disobeys would be thrown into the den of lions.
- But Daniel chose to still pray to God. He chose to continue to pray three times a day, just as he had always done, giving thanks to His God.

APPLICATION + QUESTIONS

TEACHING OBJECTIVE: JUST LIKE DANIEL, I CAN BE MIGHTY WHEN I DO THE THINGS GOD WANTS ME TO DO.

- Daniel stood strong in his faith. He took initiative to do what is right and he continued to be faithful and obedient to God.
- Daring Faith means to take initiative. We can do this by standing strong in God even when we face hard times.
- We can be mighty and have daring faith by doing what is right, even when it is difficult.
- We can choose to be faithful and obedient to God just like Daniel did!
